Adopter Hall of Fame

Carrie was one of our residents that was fostered last winter during a severe cold snap. She had been a long term Haven resident, was adopted for 3 years and returned. At 9 years old, and being a BBD (Big Black Dog), her chances of adoption

were slimmer than many other dogs.

Staff and volunteers knew she was a great girl and they asked the Elders to foster her during the extreme weather. The Elders are veteran adopters. From the Haven they have adopted a BBD with health concerns (Kristy), two sibling puppies that were under-socialized and fearful (Bailey and Patches), and Mom Brenda recently adopted puppy Noel.



We asked Stephanie to tell us about fostering Carrie, then deciding to adopt her (and change her name to Sadie).

"We really didn't know how things would go when we headed to get her at the Haven but we just knew we had an extra crate and extra room so we had to help even if it was just one dog. That would mean that one wouldn't have to sleep in the negative degree temps for a while. Hilary [Mertens, Super Volunteer] matched us up with the perfect dog and we are so grateful because she brings such light and joy to us each day!



We kept Carrie separate from our other dogs for a day then introduced them slowly. My grandma fell in love with her!

She was crated for 3 days when we went to work. My grandma, who never ever goes downstairs, went (Continued on page 2) downstairs to check on her and give her treats while we were at work. She has not been in a crate since then.

She transitioned really easily, she was housebroken already, she knows several commands, she loves to run, go for walks and go for rides! She fit in like she had always been part of our pack of 7.

She's out all day and night in the living room and naps on the couch. She has bonded with us so well! It took a while, but I think she knows she's home and not going anywhere now. I've never been so thankful for horrible cold because it gave us something we didn't even know we needed- Sadie Bug.

Oh, she still jumps straight up and down each morning as soon as I grab my shoes, she loves to play outside, go for walks or just ride in the car. She is one of the best travel, go-everywhere-with-me dogs I've ever had! She's so funny. Her vet check up went fantastic this week and they fell in love with her too!"

How can you properly thank a family that has been such a help to so many deserving animals? We don't know, but Thank You Elders!

Well Repair

One thing the Haven definitely needs in the summer is water, so when the water quit running, it was an emergency. Thankfully, we had someone respond to our call for help. They discovered the pump needed to be replaced. Haven staffers Colter, Makenzie and Kayla helped take the roof off the old well house. Clean water was flowing by the end of the day. Well repairs and related work cost close to \$2,000.

Standard adoption fees are \$125 for puppies up to 10 months old, \$90 for dogs from 10 months to 5 years old, \$75 for dogs over 5 years old, \$75 for kittens under 6 months old, and \$65 for cats 6 months and older. Fees for certain dogs may vary.

All pets are spayed or neutered, up-to-date on vaccinations, and microchipped prior to adoption. Animals must be returned if placement is not successful.
